Following members were present.




The meeting was chaired by Dr. P.S. Deshmukh, President, ISPP. Dr. Deshmukh welcomed all the members and requested Dr. G.C. Srivastava, Hon. Secretary to start with the agenda items.

Dr. Srivastava explained to the members that there was acute shortage of space for keeping the records of the ISPP awards applications and the manuscripts of the research papers submitted to the Society for publication in Indian Journal of Plant Physiology. It was also emphasized that as per the instructions of IARI authorities, Society has to move all the furniture and records immediately to the small room allotted to the Society at the NASC complex.

All the members unanimously decided that since the award applications were the property of individual applicants, and also do not involve any financial obligations on the part of the Society, the same should be destroyed after one year of the announcement of the awards. Similarly it was also decided that all the original and revised manuscripts of the papers selected for the publication in Indian Journal of Plant Physiology, and also those rejected by the Society will be destroyed after one year of publications/rejection.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
